# **Annual report for 2023**

#### What is CYC?

Cyc has existed since 1997. The organization was registered 2008 as an NGO with the Lebanese government and changed its name to "The Children & Youth Association". The organization has its main operation in Shatila with a subsection in the refugee camp Nahr El Bared since the camp war there 2007. CYC offers a meeting place for the children and youths in the refugee camp. In their free time they receive help with schoolwork and take part in other meaningful and enriching activities.

Abu Mujahed is the director of the organization.

CYC's fundamental pillar: Locally led work organized by a committee of elected youths plan the work together with Abu Mujahed. The activities are planned at open meetings for the participants. Children's and youth's participation in the planning and equal terms for girls and boys. Child - tochild method (children helping children) is the basis of how the activities are organized. The UN's convention on the rights of the child is the guideline when the organization's content is decided.

This fundraising foundation was established in the year 2000 to:

1. Support the activities conducted by The Children & Youth Association. The foundation collects money from sponsors and is given gifts and donations from individuals and

- organizations. The funds raised are sent to agreed-upon activities that benefit the children and youths there.
- 2. Spread information about the situation for children and youths in Palestinian refugee camps in Lebanon.

The fundraising foundation is non-governmental and independent.

#### The year 2023

CYC had a great start for 2023. Corona was finally over, the center could again become the meeting place it was meant to be, that cares about knowledge, the environment and climate, solidarity, equality and security. A place that gives hope for a better future.

When the Palestinian refugee camp Jenin, in the West Bank, was attacked in the spring, the children held a spontaneous demonstration. The center arranged a storytelling performance about Palestinian life and history with folkdance, Dabke, and music. The group was invited to perform at different events, festivals and gatherings, for example, the Palestinian Earth day March 30<sup>th</sup>, the Naqba day May 15<sup>th</sup> and the summer activities closure.

The center continued its work helping the school children reach their goals, getting the results and grades they need.

Lebanese society faces bankruptcy, poverty increased, public schools were often closed. UNWRA schools had overfull classrooms and the teachers' faced problems with meeting the needs of each student. The CYC continued its work with helping with homework and with the "Protection program for Syrian children". This is for the Syrian children that are not offered enrollment in public school because of political reasons since the war in Syria. CYC teaches base level English, Arabic and math. Not as a school but in the spirit of public education. This is a continuation of the project that went on from 2022 and into the beginning of 2023, to mitigate the rise of analphabetism. The project funds ran out, but the work continued, partially with funds from our foundation.

Kindergarten Alma is led by Malake, she and Nancy are the head teachers. With fine pedagogic methods, they guide the children (3-6 yrs) in seeing and experiencing letters and numbers, preparing them for school. They practice working in groups, playing and having fun together. The parents are very pleased, knowing the children are content there. Please visit our website faddershatila.se, under links, news articles and reports. There you can find Luca Di Blanca's article from the CYC and many photos. The article is also ai translated to Swedish (from Italian). In 2023 (as in 2022) children from Hammarkulle primary school in Gothenburg held a fundraiser to benefit the CYC. With the help of school personnel, they organized "Café Shatila" during the popular Hammarkulle festival in at the end of May. The children work hard selling coffee, sodas, baked goods, sandwiches, pizza slices and more. The profit was donated in solidarity with CYC. With the funds from the café, together with funds raised during fall activities in 2022 at Mixgården (a youth center in Hammarkullen), where several children from Hammarkulle school helped, we were able to send \$1450 to the CYC. The board visited the children at the start of the fall semester to personally thank them. We hoped to have an online meeting between the school and Youth center but were not able to due to technical difficulties. A video greeting with questions about life in the camp and how the collected funds will be used was sent instead. At the end of the year, we received a video back from the children at the Youth center, they described how the funds were welcomed during the summer activities and excursions. Photos and videos can be found on the website.

During three weeks in July, CYC organized summer activities for over 100 children. They held sessions in the library, received some extra tutoring, and played in the yard. They created art and enjoyed much-needed snacks. They went on excursions to the Skatepark and other places in Beirut. The final day was a celebration with games, dancing, and an exhibition of the children's drawings and other creations. Families were invited as guests.

A surplus from the sale of "Diary from Tal El-Zaatar" raised 33,275 SEK during 2022 and 2023. Celanders Publishing sent the money to our fundraiser. The artist and friend of Palestine, Majlis Davidsson from Alingsås, had included the foundation in their will, so we gratefully received a surprising donation of 33,563 SEK. A sponsor donated books about the Middle East, politics, and history. We sold several at the Peace Race (Fredsloppet) but still have some books left. We will send out a list so interested parties can purchase them.

## Peace Race (Fredsloppet) 2023

As usual, we applied for a visa for Abu Moujahed, and it was granted. We also applied for a young girl at the center, Lara, but she was denied. Unfortunately, Abu Moujahed's passport was stolen a few days before departure, so he could not come here. The Peace Race, Sponsor Meeting, and visit to the children at Hammarkulleskolan were carried out without his presence. We planned for online contact during the sponsor meeting, but the technical setup failed.

The Pedagogical Design Agency (Den Pedagogiska Designbyrån), led by Frida Lindberg, traveled to Beirut at the end of September. They conducted a week-long training in Animated Film Creation. Nancy and six young people had two wonderful days with DPD.

After October 7, nothing was the same in Shatila anymore.

During a phone call, Abu Moujahed described how everyone anxiously sought news, many have relatives in Gaza, people demonstrated and mourned. Old traumas resurfaced, and anxiety grew. The death toll rose, Israel bombed from the air and sea and tried to penetrate Gaza with tanks. Nothing improved until the end of the year, instead everything became increasingly terrible. The West Bank also experienced severe violence, including killings, settlers, and the Israeli army attacked Palestinian homes in collaboration. A genocide was ongoing and continues. Over 11,000 children have been killed as of this writing. The children at CYC ask questions. We have learned that the Convention on the Rights of the Child applies to all children, but apparently not Palestinian children...? What will happen to us? How will we ever be able to trust you (Global North)?

At the end of November, the CYC management team gathered to evaluate and discuss the work done during the past year and plan for the future. About thirty people attended, and the meeting elected a new board consisting of seven people.

The work must continue despite the new situation, KG Alma's little children need their regular routines, and school children need their center to feel good. One can only rejoice and admire the strength found in CYC. The light in the darkness.
